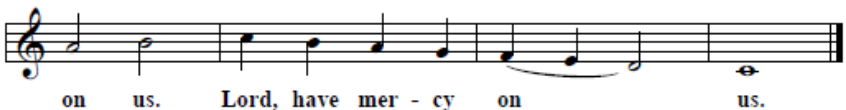

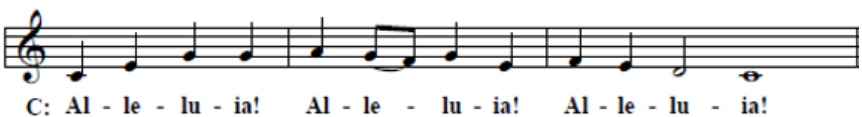
Revelation 1:4-8
