P Today we celebrate Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. On this day, more than two-thousand years ago, our Lord Jesus entered Jerusalem to begin His Passion. It was our sin that brought Jesus to the gates of Zion to suffer. The sinless for the sinner. The guiltless for the guilty. The blood of God shed for the sin of man.

P Jesus entered the city seated upon a lowly donkey, a beast of burden. The crowds and the children cried out, “Hosanna!”, which means, “save now!” And it was precisely for this reason that Christ came to the place of His death: to bear our burden of sin and to suffer the penalty of God’s wrath our iniquity had incurred. He came to “save now”.

6 And they spoke to them just as Jesus had commanded. ‘Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!’

11 And Jesus went into Jerusalem and into the temple. So when He had looked around at all things, as the hour was already late, He went out to Bethany with the twelve.
