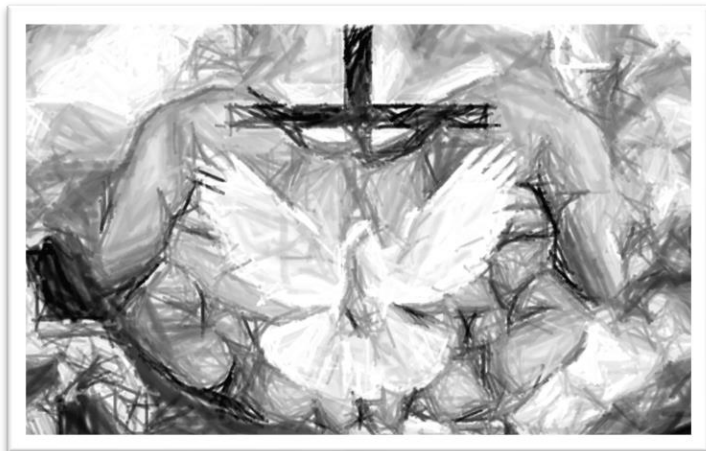

## Athanasian Creed (*printed on bulletin half-sheet*)

*The Athanasian Creed is one of the three ecumenical creeds (used by almost all of Christendom), along with the Apostle’s and Nicene Creeds. It is traditional to profess it on Trinity Sunday because of its clear, repeated emphasis on what the bible teaches concerning the doctrine of the Trinity.*

*With the eyes of faith we hold to what Scripture teaches, and with our mouths we confess what we cannot understand. Lord, grant us humility!*

But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

6 And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" 7 Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.
